APQN requests a proposal covering a brief introduction of your company, the legal registration, technical quality, organizational and management capabilities, staff qualifications and experience and quotation for the website development and annual maintenance service. Quotation should specify charges for two things separately: 1. For design and development as mentioned in points a to j above 2. For annual maintenance including tech support, improvement, hosting charges, etc. In both case taxes should also be specified.

KEY FINDINGS

To optimize the user experience, it is recommended to consolidate and reduce the length of sub-menus to eliminate unnecessary content repetition.

In summary, to elevate the design and improve the professional image of the APQN website, it is recommended to update the overall design, improve navigation, structure content in a better way, add clear calls to action, make the website mobile responsive, and incorporate visual elements. By implementing these changes, the website will be more user-friendly and engaging, which will help the organization to better communicate its objectives and engage with its target audience.

HOMEPAGE




We have identified several key issues with the current Homepage layout:

Overall, the website's homepage could benefit from clearer headlines, more visual elements, and updated content to effectively communicate the organization's mission and objectives to visitors. Improving the navigation and footer as well as providing essential information such as the organization's history, vision, and values would also help build trust with potential stakeholders.

ABOUT US







Key Issues:

- 1. Lengthy sub-menus: A long list sub-menus may distract visitors from the key information. It should be simplified by combining some of the sub-menus into 1 page and rearrange the sub-menu list. This will make it easier for visitors to navigate and less overwhelming.
- **2.** Lack of filtering and sorting options: While the website does provide a search function, there is no option to filter or sort the membership list by membership type, countries, or other criteria. This can make it difficult for users to quickly find the information they are looking for.
- 3. Lack of visual hierarchy: The website's design could benefit from better visual hierarchy to help users quickly identify important information. For example, the membership types could be visually differentiated from each other, and the institution names could be more prominently displayed. Additionally, it would be best to adopt simple and neat typography that does not overwhelm visitors.








Simplify the membership information page: To optimize the visitor experience, we recommend
