

- In order to enhance expertise in university accreditation, the Korean Council for University Education (KCUE) has created a pool of evaluators drawn from those who experienced evaluating universities or who are related experts. The pool has been put together based on the recommendation by member university (3~6 recommendees per university). The number of evaluators are 352, which shows enough representativeness.
- The pool of evaluators will continue to be added on a yearly basis. Considering that Institutional Accreditation is a way of evaluation which values expertise of evaluators, the pool is formed mostly with those who experienced university evaluation or those who have their position in university management for now. However, as the institution accreditation gets settled more and more, the ratios of evaluators from research and industry will be expanded in a gradual manner.
- In the event that the KCUE conducts accreditation with 10 teams a year, it allocates 6 evaluators to each team. In such case, the number of evaluators who carry out evaluations annually would be 60, only about one fifth of the pool that the council has. Given this, it is viewed that the council has secured enough number of evaluators.
